# **DOCK SHELTER**

Gateway Dock Shelters are a "drive-in" shelter, where trucks back into the shelter causing the face panels to wrap around the sides and the top of the truck for a weather tight seal. The face panels move out of the way on contact allowing full access to the truck opening. Personnel and equipment work inside under positive protection, eliminating damage to merchandise by rain, snow, wind.


22 ounce, 40 ounce and Hi-tear Black Vinyl

### **CONSTRUCTION ~**

Pressure treated wood frame construction is covered on top and sides with white vinyl panels to allow natural light to filter through into the loading area. Aluminum angle trim provides a finished look.

Fiberglass stays in protective pocket covers provide positive spring loaded contact of head and side curtains to top and sides of trailer body.

Foam bead on leading edge of side curtains hug the sides of the trailer body.
